<p>1. Photo Montage Project Introduction to Adobe Premiere, camera shots and angles, and storyboarding pictures (must choose theme). Students will learn how to import pictures, add music, use transitions and video effects. <p>2. 30 sec. Commercial Project Students will be introduced to the key elements of video production. For example, students will learn about lighting and props, writing a script, as well as camera usage. All students will be expected to know different types of camera angles and how to create them. Students will learn how to properly use a tripod, capture video clips and editing actual video footage. <p>3. Music Video Project Each student will be responsible for creating their own music video. Research will be done on what type of video to create based on the target audience. <p>4. 10 Min. Movie Project Students will write and produce their own movie. Students will learn how to write a script and plan a full length production. Each student must appear on screen at some point during the film.
